WHAT DOES C-III CAPITAL PARTNERS LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Social Security number ▪ Account balances, account transactions and transaction history ▪ Wire transfer instructions and investment experience
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons C-III Capital Partners LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What We Do

How does C-III protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does C-III collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Open an account ▪ Seek advice about your investments ▪ Provide account information ▪ Enter into an investment advisory contract ▪ Make a wire transfer <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as affiliates or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing with affiliates' everyday business purposes---information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you; and ▪ sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account -- unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Our affiliates include companies with a C-III name; financial companies such as Island Capital Group LLC, Anubis Securities LLC, Island Investment Management LLC and C-III Investment Management LLC; nonfinancial companies; and others, such as C-III Realty Services LLC (d/b/a NAI Global), New America Network Inc., and The Planning & Zoning Resource Company LLC.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Nonaffiliates we share with can include various service providers to assist in the administration of the investment funds and accounts advised by C-III and its subsidiaries and affiliates.
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>C-III does not jointly market.</i>

Other important information

Nevada: If you are a consumer with a Nevada mailing address, we are providing you this notice under state law. Vermont: If you are consumer with a Vermont mailing address, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of C-III, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent or to service your accounts. We will not share information about your creditworthiness within our corporate family except with your consent, but we may share information about our transactions or experiences with you within our corporate family without your consent.

California: If you are a consumer with a California mailing address, we will not share information we collect about you with companies outside of C-III, unless the law allows. For example, we may share information with your consent, to service your accounts, or to provide rewards or benefits to which you are entitled.
